AGREEMENTS OF COOPERATION BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY OF GJIROKASTRA AND GREEK UNIVERSITIES, SIGNED BY THE RECTORS OF THE RESPECTIVE INSTITUTIONS

The University of Gjirokastra has intensified its efforts to find ways to further benefit from the cooperation with analog Greek institutions. After the signing of the Protocol of Cooperation with the University of Ioannina, another important step towards the internationalization of our institution was the signing of the Agreement of Cooperation between “Eqrem Çabej” University and the University of Western Macedonia, in May 2022.

During the meeting, the Rectors of both Universities emphasized the fact that this agreement marks a new stage of cooperation that will be the turning point in our bilateral relations. They focused on issues of common institutional interest and the next steps for the development of joint activities

related to scientific research, exchange of staff and students, creation of summer schools, application and implementation of research projects and those co-financed by the Erasmus+ or IPA program, joint organization of scientific conferences, the cooperation between the Life-long Learning Centers of both institutions, etc.

The meeting, which was organized in the form of an exchange of ideas on the development of both universities and the cooperation between the parties will be followed by concrete steps related to close cooperation between faculties or special departments.



EXCELLENT PARTICIPATION OF “EQREM CABEJ” UNIVERSITY AT PCU GAMES, ANTWERP, BELGIUM

Each year in April, the University of Antwerp, Belgium hosts the PCU Games, an international sporting event for Universities and Colleges worldwide, held under the Fair Play auspices of Panathlon International. Teams of males or females compete in Futsal, Basketball, or Volleyball.

This year more than 500 participants and 43 teams from 23 universities in 16 countries were present at the opening ceremony of the PCU Games 2022, organized at the University of Antwerp on April 27th-29th. The team of the University of Gjirokastra performed with dignity and was ranked second in the Futsal category for males bringing home a merited victory.

However, this is not the first time our team has succeeded in Futsal. Being created a decade ago, it has been part of a number of competitions and has won different prizes. The trainer, Prof. Arjan Pano works hard with the team members, but he is also inclined to make newcomers adopt the spirit of the team.

With the aim that the students of the Faculty of Law of the Public University "Kadri Zeka" in Gjilan, the theoretical knowledge acquired during studies in the field of criminalistic techniques, tactics and methodology, to expand them in the practical field, a practical exercise was held by Prof. Asst. Dr. Fejzullah Hasani, Prof. Asst. Dr. Fatmire Krasniqi and Dr. Sc. Besim Arifi with the topic "Inspection of the place of the event".

During the practical exercise carried out in the courtyard

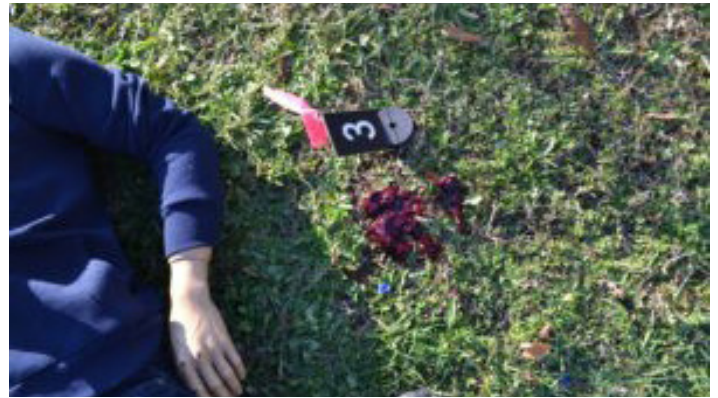
of the University, the students were recently introduced to some of the most efficient tools and methods in the function of research, discovery and clarification of traces with a direct impact on the process of identifying the perpetrator of the criminal offense and the offense specific criminal charges.

Through the conducted exercise, cases were simulated and students saw how investigative actions are carried out in real life in terms of: searching, fixing, documenting, photographing, measuring, sketching the place of the event

as well as examining all traces and material evidence which are found in that country.

The exercise is dedicated especially to the students of the second and third year of bachelor's studies of the Faculty of Law as well as students of the Master-Juridical-Penal Program.

The means of concretization used in the exercise were a doll (in the form of a victim), a shell, a liquid substance in the form of blood, white paper, a camera, a laptop with a projector and other auxiliary means in order to carry out the exercise.



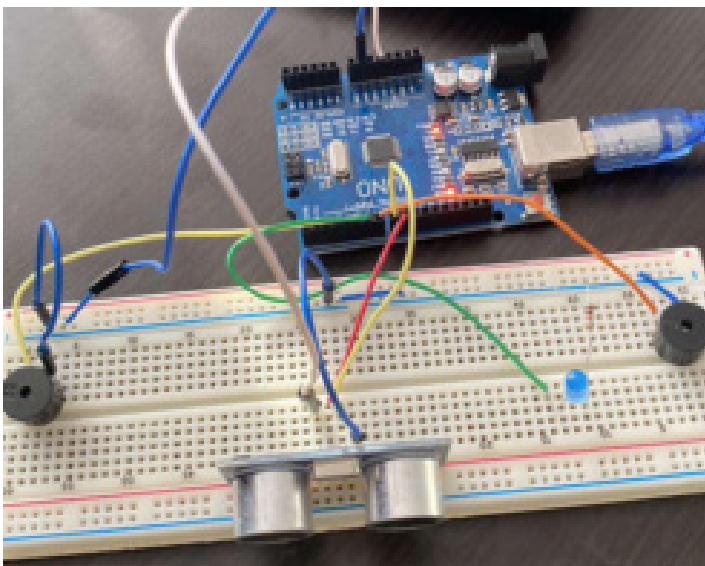
AFC STUDENTS HAVE PRESENTED PRACTICAL WORKS FOR SEW PROJECTS

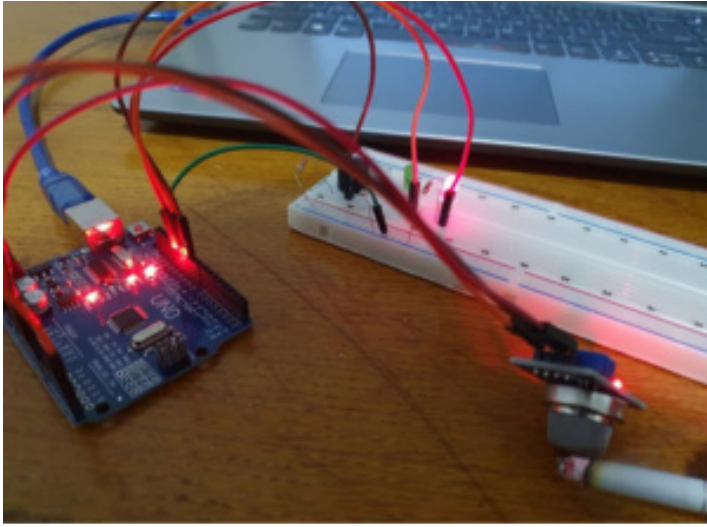

Each project has gone through the phase of reasoning the idea, providing the hardware devices, providing the code in the C++ programming language, connecting, modifying, documenting, testing and finally the theoretical presentation as well as the most interesting part, the practical demonstration. All projects are mentored by Prof. Assoc. Dr. Basri Ahmedi.

We are presenting all four projects separately:

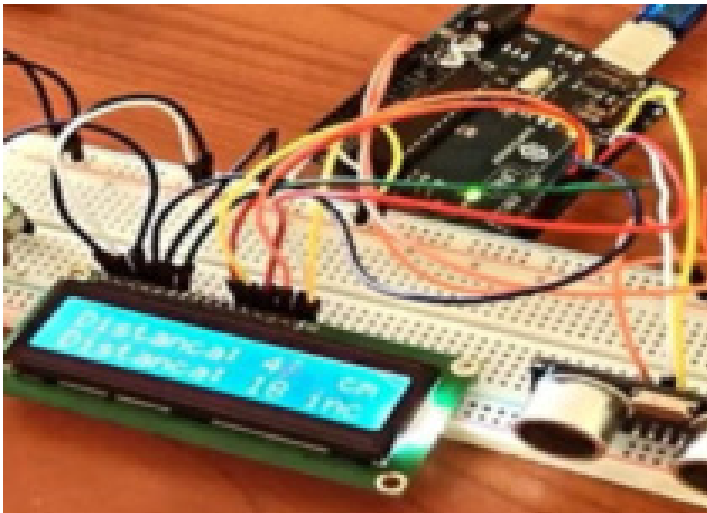

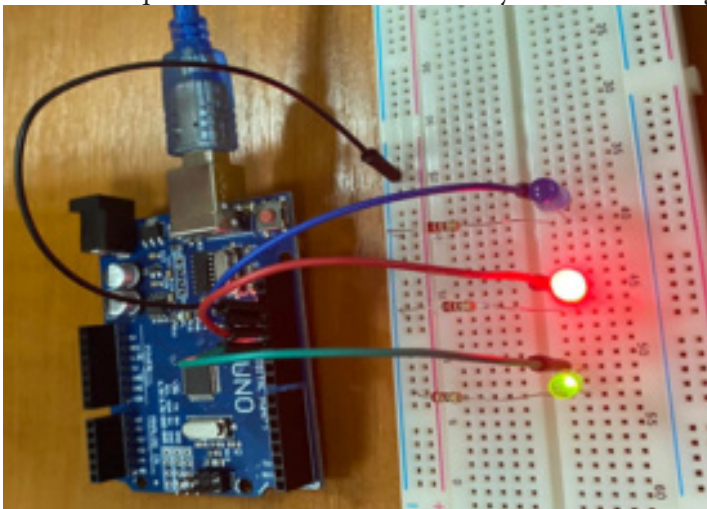

- LED Sequential Control was realized by the students Anglianina Avdyli and Lorita Rahimi.

The Annual International Scientific Conference "Scientific Identity and Creativity in a Changed World", organized by the Public University "Kadri Zeka" in Gjilan, has gathered well-known personalities from science such as academics, university professors from well-known universities such as Riga (Latvia), Barcelona (Spain), Izmir (Turkey), University of Cyprus, etc., but also professors and young researchers from the country, the region and Europe.

Prof. Dr. Xhevdet Thaqi, chairman of the Organizational Council, presented the Scientific Research and Development Community of the Conference, where the panelists were Academician Shinasi Sinani from Albania, Prof. Dr. Yuly Venegas from University of Lleida, Spain, Academician Fejzullah Krasniqi from ASHK of Kosovo.



The opening of the Conference was made by the Rector of the Public University "Kadri Zeka" in Gjilan, Prof. Dr. Bajram Kosumi, who greeted the attendees, welcoming you to the conference. The Rector said that this Conference that has gathered us today is oriented towards the dynamics of information technology, education, scientific research, and the global market. The rector said that education is a process of permanent reformation, where digital technology has globalized society and the labor market, which creates a very high global competition for a job. He added that a large part of graduates risk being left without a job, so according to Rector Kosumi, the University cannot continue with the traditional profile, because the University produces students for the labor market and this conference is helpful in this regard.



The Mayor of the Municipality of Gjilan, Alban Hyseni, in his speech, congratulated the Conference, meanwhile he said that the municipality is interested in developing the economic area, especially the development of the achievement of knowledge. The President said that digitization is also a priority for us, which is the future that we must necessarily focus on. In the organization of this conference, added the president Hyseni, it is very important to identify the barriers, because these challenges are common and we must deal with them together.

Rector of the University of Elbasan, Prof. Dr. Skender Topi, after greeting those present, said that our great Albania has a very big problem, such as brain migration. According to him, in a research done by the Albanian American Foundation, it is evident that there are over 4 thousand Albanian PHD candidates in the whole world and we need a foundation to support them so that we can share their experience that they have in all universities. through our universities, to come and contribute to us. He added that Albanian Universities should create an Erasmus within the Balkans, including Macedonia, Kosovo and Albania, and organize such joint conferences.



Rector of the University of Pristina, Prof. Dr. Naser Sahiti, after congratulating the Conference, emphasized that some of the topics such as the issue of interdisciplinarity, brain drain or even digitization are basic concepts, they are current things for which the conference will give indications of how it will be within the framework of developments ours.

The rector of the University of Gjakova, Dr. Sc. Dr. Artan Nimani, after congratulating the Conference, said that today's organization is a good step for the advancement of Albania and thus together we can move forward.

The trainings are part of the main activity “Career guidance of students and mobility of target groups”, within the framework of the OMNIA Project, contract No. BG05M2OP001-2.016-0007, funded by the Operational Programme “Science and Education for Smart Growth”, co-financed by the EU through the European Structural and Investment Funds.

The entrepreneurship course was developed on the specifics of health business relations and 270 students from MU-Plovdiv participated in it. Within 10 study modules, the medical students were comprehensively introduced to various economic specialties in order to gain knowledge about the important thematic areas of the functioning of a company such as: management, human resources management, law, marketing, accounting, as well as skills for free establishment, operation and management of business units.

279 Bulgarian and foreign students from all faculties of MU-Plovdiv participated in the soft skills training. They studied 10 subjects: Public Speaking, Communication Skills, Leadership, Effective Learning Methods, Motivation, Teamwork, Conflict Resolution, Time Management, Stress Management and DISC Profiling.

The OMNIA project (from Latin “everything”) is implemented by Medical University of Plovdiv in partnership with Medical University of Sofia, Medical University of Plevan, Thrace University - Stara Zagora, National Sports Academy “Vasil Levski”, Plovdiv University “Paisii Hilendarski”, University of Food Technology – Plovdiv, National Center for Infectious and Parasitic Diseases and the Institute of Molecular Biology at the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences. Associated partners of the project are: Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (Greece), Ecclesiastical Academy of Athens (Greece), Democritus University of Thrace Medical School (Greece), Site de Creil – GHPSO (France), Università Campus Bio-Medico di Roma (Italy), University of West Attica (Greece).

The main goal of the project is to contribute to achieving a dynamic match between the demand and supply of specialists with higher education through the modernization of educational processes in universities. For this purpose, 9 new study programs will be developed, digitized and put into practice, through which a competency model, multidisciplinary and interdisciplinarity will be ensured in the education of the students.



ISTANBUL FACULTY OF MEDICINE HAS ACHIEVED A FIRST IN THE FIELD OF 'ROBOTIC SURGERY'

The Associate Professor Dr. from the Department of General Surgery of the Department of Surgical Medical Sciences of the Istanbul Faculty of Medicine, Dr. Nihat Aksakal and Dr. Lecturer Yalın İçsan managed to remove a rare lump on the right adrenal gland of a 77-year-old patient close to her main veins with robotic surgery.

"The Last Point Where Surgery Arrives"

Associate Prof. Dr. Nihat Aksakal and Dr. Lecturer Yalın İçsan detected a lump suspected of having a tumor on the adrenal gland of Emine Altiner. The doctors decided to do surgery and the robotic surgical intervention performed on Altiner, described as "posterior retroperitoneal robotic tumor excision", took about 1.5 hours. During the operation, a slightly larger lump than the egg was removed from Altiner's body. Robotic surgery, described as 'the last point where surgery arrives', was reported to have been performed for the first time in such a critical region of the body.

Associate Professor Dr. Nihat Aksakal told an AA (Anatolian Agency) reporter: "We decided to take the lump with a surgery because of the possibility of a tumor with a diameter of about 4.5 centimeters, close to the main veins of the body and back as of the area where it is located, behind the abdomen. Besides, we did not know if it was benign or malignant, perhaps metastasize if it was not intervened in time. We have come to the conclusion that this operation can be completed indoors with the Da Vinci robot in our Faculty."

The First In Robotic Surgery

Dr. Aksakal stated that they called this surgery "The first one in the world" and added: "Adrenal gland tumors have been performed by robots from the back for many years. But these (the back of the abdomen outside the adrenal gland) lumps are both rare and somewhat difficult to reach. We previously performed these surgeries endoscopically. When we looked at the literature, we saw that these lumps, which we call 'extra-adrenal retroperitoneal' masses, were the first in robotic surgery (from the back)."

PROF. DR. SAADET KARAKULAK AND HER TEAM TOOK PART IN THE PROJECT FOR DETERMINATION OF SEA SNAIL STOCKS IN THE WESTERN BLACK SEA REGION

Prof. Dr. Saadet Karakulak and her team from İstanbul University Faculty of Water Sciences participated in the studies within the scope of the Project for Determination of Sea Snail (*Rapana Venosa*) Stocks in the Western Black Sea Region.

Within the framework of the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) General Fisheries Commission for the Mediterranean (GFCM), the first large-scale study to investigate the population of the sea snail began in 2020. The scientific work continued at the same time in the waters of Bulgaria, Georgia, Romania, Turkey, and Ukraine.

Prof. Dr. Saadet Karakulak from İU Faculty of Water Sciences and her team were responsible for the research of this Project in the Western Black Sea region. Scientific marine studies were made to understand the temporal (annual and seasonal) and spatial changes of the sea snail, and twice a year in the spring and autumn period, marine expeditions were conducted. Between June 22 – July 24, 2022, the fourth expedition of this Project was done. Besides, within the scope of the Project, trawl shots were done and samples were taken at a total of 83 stations between İğneada and Sinop.

About the Sea Snail- *Rapana Venosa*

The sea snail- *rapana venosa* is an invasive species that first entered the Black Sea in the 1950s through the ballast waters of a ship. This species has multiplied rapidly in the Black Sea, becoming a threat to other molluscs. But over time, the sea snail has become an increasingly important source of income for local fishermen and aquaculture processing factories. Hunting started in the 1980s.

Today the sea snail is exported globally and represents millions of dollars of income for the Black Sea riparian countries. Small-scale fishermen, who make up more than 85 percent of the Black Sea's fishing fleet, hunt sea snails in particular. It is very important to determine the stock status with scientific research in order to make fishery sustainable.

**DR. LECTURER BENAL GÜL TALKED ABOUT
'THE ARTIFICIAL REEF PROJECT'**

Dr. Lecturer Benal Gül, the faculty member of the İstanbul University Faculty of Water Sciences, whose area of expertise is artificial reefs, talked about their Project.

Dr. Gül said "We are among the few countries in the world that have the National Artificial Reef Master Plan, that is, where artificial reefs can be made on the shores of the country" and added: "As of 2011, the first project funded by the Ministry of Agriculture was implemented in Edremit Bay within the framework of the National Artificial Reef Master Plan."

Artificial Reef Areas Around the Princes' Islands

Dr. Gül said that the artificial reef studies on the shores of İstanbul began in 2019. Dr. Gül said that the opinions of many institutions, organizations and people were taken during the preliminary preparation period in this region, which is located in residential areas, where underwater structures, pipelines and electrical cables are dense.

The project was carried out by İstanbul Provincial Directorate of Agriculture and Forestry, Fisheries and Fisheries Department. For the work to be done, three artificial reef areas have been identified in a protected area around the İstanbul Princes' Islands, which are

completely closed to industrial fishing. Dr. Gül listed these areas as follows: "Kınalıada, Heybeliada and Büyükada shores. In addition, a point was determined on the shores of Sarayburnu in front of Ahırkapı."

Biodiversity in Artificial Reefs Is Increasing Every Day

According to Dr. Gül, in the monitoring studies in Kınalıada and Heybeliada, 11 fish species and 20 non-fish marine creatures are nesting on artificial reefs. Among them are swallow and decoy fish, sea peonies, a wide variety of sea stars, sea eggplants, squids, stingrays, lobsters. Dr. Gül underlined that they carry out monthly water sampling and new nests are detected every time. "Therefore, we can say that the biodiversity in artificial reefs is increasing every day."

Dr. Lecturer Benal Gül added: "We are also carrying out a TÜBİTAK project titled 'The Effect of Mucilage on Artificial Reef Succession and Fisheries Efficiency' regarding the studies carried out in the region."

“Sustainability and Structural Design Day 6 - Workshop on Prefabrication and Sustainability with Traditional Materials” which is about the sustainability of industrial structures, energy efficiency, and prefabrication was held at Tekirdağ Namık Kemal University Rectorate Conference Hall and the Foyer Area under the “Only 1 Day” concept.

Vice-rectors Prof. Dr. Bülent EKER, and Prof. Dr. Yılmaz ÇAKICI, representatives from institutions and organizations, NGOs, industrialists and business people, managers of companies, academic and administrative staff, and students attended the workshop which was held in memory of Namık EREN, a construction engineer.

In his opening speech, Vice Rector Prof. Dr. Bülent EKER stated that “The material we use ranges from the daily items we use to the clothes we wear. The material changes shape. In ancient times, stone and sticks were materials, but today, the concept of the material has changed in various aspects. There is even a shift towards nano-materials”.

Prof. Dr. Funda ERYILMAZ AÇIKGÖZ, the Director of the Vocational School of Technical Sciences stated that the workshop was organized by the Department of Construction in the Vocational School of Technical Sciences and she introduced the Vocational School of

Technical Sciences to the participants. She also explained the advantages of the internship program called 3+1 which consists of theoretical courses in three semesters and practical training in the industry for one semester.

Following the opening speeches, sessions with industry and academics on the sustainability of industrial structures were carried out face to face. In the presentations, the architectural design and sustainability of the industrial structures of various industries such as pharmaceuticals, aluminum, new generation industrial sites, textile and building element manufacturers were examined and assessed on the urban scale.

Simultaneously with the workshop, the student projects from the Architecture and Construction Department in the field of sustainability and structural design were exhibited at the TNKU Exhibition Center. In the ‘Student Presentations’ session, representatives of the working groups also had the opportunity to introduce to the participants the materials they produced in group studies and present their added value in terms of sustainability.

The workshop and exhibition continued throughout the day. Over 700 participants attended the event and it was broadcast live on NKU TV YouTube channel.

VISIT OF TRAKYA UNIVERSITY RECTOR PROF. DR. ERHAN TABAKOĞLU AND HIS DELEGATION TO KIRCAALI

Trakya University delegation led by Rector Prof. Dr. Erhan Tabakolu visited Krcaali, Bulgaria. The delegation, consisting of Vice-Rector Prof. Dr. Murat Türkyılmaz and Dean of the Faculty of Health Sciences Prof. Dr. Sedat Üstündağ, first visited Kırcaali Municipality where they met with Mayor Hasan Azis. Later, the delegation met with Bulgarian doctors at Kırcaali Dr. Atanas Dafovski Hospital. During the meeting, Prof. Dr. Sedat Üstündağ, the Dean of the Faculty of Health Sciences at Trakya University, emphasized the importance of preventing, diagnosing, and treating hypertension. He shared the latest developments in the field.

Before the meeting that brought together Trakya University and Bulgarian physicians, the Trakya University delegation led by Rector Prof. Dr. Erhan Tabakoğlu met with Kırcaali Mayor Hasan Azis in his office. Mayor Azis welcomed Trakya University to Kırcaali. He emphasized

the significance of the meeting for the region's public health and preventive healthcare services.

Prof. Dr. Sedat Üstündağ shared the latest hypertension developments with Bulgarian doctors. After a visit to Kırcaali Municipality, the Trakya University delegation, accompanied by Mayor Hasan Azis, met with Chief Physician Prof. Dr. Todor Cherkezov, Bulgarian doctors, and healthcare workers at Dr. Atanas Dafovski Hospital. During his speech, Rector Prof. Dr. Erhan Tabakoğlu thanked Mayor Hasan Azis and Chief Physician Prof. Dr. Todor Cherkezov for the opportunity to have such a meeting. He talked about Trakya University's activities and close relationships with Bulgaria in education, environment, and health issues. He mentioned that Trakya University is ready to share its facilities, including its 1100-bed hospital, state-of-the-art infrastructure, and expert staff, with neighboring Bulgaria. Prof. Dr. Sedat Üstündağ, Dean of the Faculty of Health Sciences, expressed his pleasure in meeting Bulgarian doctors and addressing them. He thanked Mayor Hasan Azis and Chief Physician Prof. Dr. Todor Cherkezov for this opportunity. He defined hypertension and shared current data, calling it the world's most silent and horrific killer. He emphasized that every year, 200 million people worldwide suffer from stroke, heart attack, and other diseases due to late diagnosis and treatment of hypertension. In addition, 10.4 million people die prematurely each year due to hypertension-related problems. Prof. Dr. Sedat Üstündağ compared the number of deaths caused by hypertension with World War I and the COVID-19 pandemic. He underlined that hypertension kills 28,500 people. Silently every day and 10.4 million people every year.



AID FROM BALKAN COUNTRIES FOR EARTHQUAKE-HIT TURKEY

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THE STUDENTS OF VFU “CHERNORIZETS HRABER” UNIVERSITY GIVE AN EXCELLENT MARK OF 5.62 ON THE QUALITY OF THE LEARNING PROCESS AT THE UNIVERSITY

The students of the Varna Free University “Chernorizets Hrabar” give an excellent mark of 5.62 to the quality of the educational process at the university. The results summarise the opinion of 4,478 students in 517 disciplines taught at the university. The survey is part of the regular student satisfaction inquiry that takes place at the end of the academic year. The results show sustainability - this year they are similar to last year's, but with 15% more inquiries conducted. The analysis was discussed at a meeting of the Academic Council of VFU “Chernorizets Hrabar”.

With the highest student rating are the courses in the professional area of Administration and Management - 5.82, followed by Economics with 5.77 and Security and Safety with 5.76. Right after them are the courses of Legal Sciences - 5.67. The major in Psychology also received an excellent mark. The Smolyan branch of the university received 5.69. The courses at Architecture and Urban Studies and Construction of Buildings and Structures are respectively with 5.58 and 5.71. Traditionally, students rate the lectures at the Department of Foreign Language Teaching and Postgraduate Qualification very highly – this year the mark is 5.84.

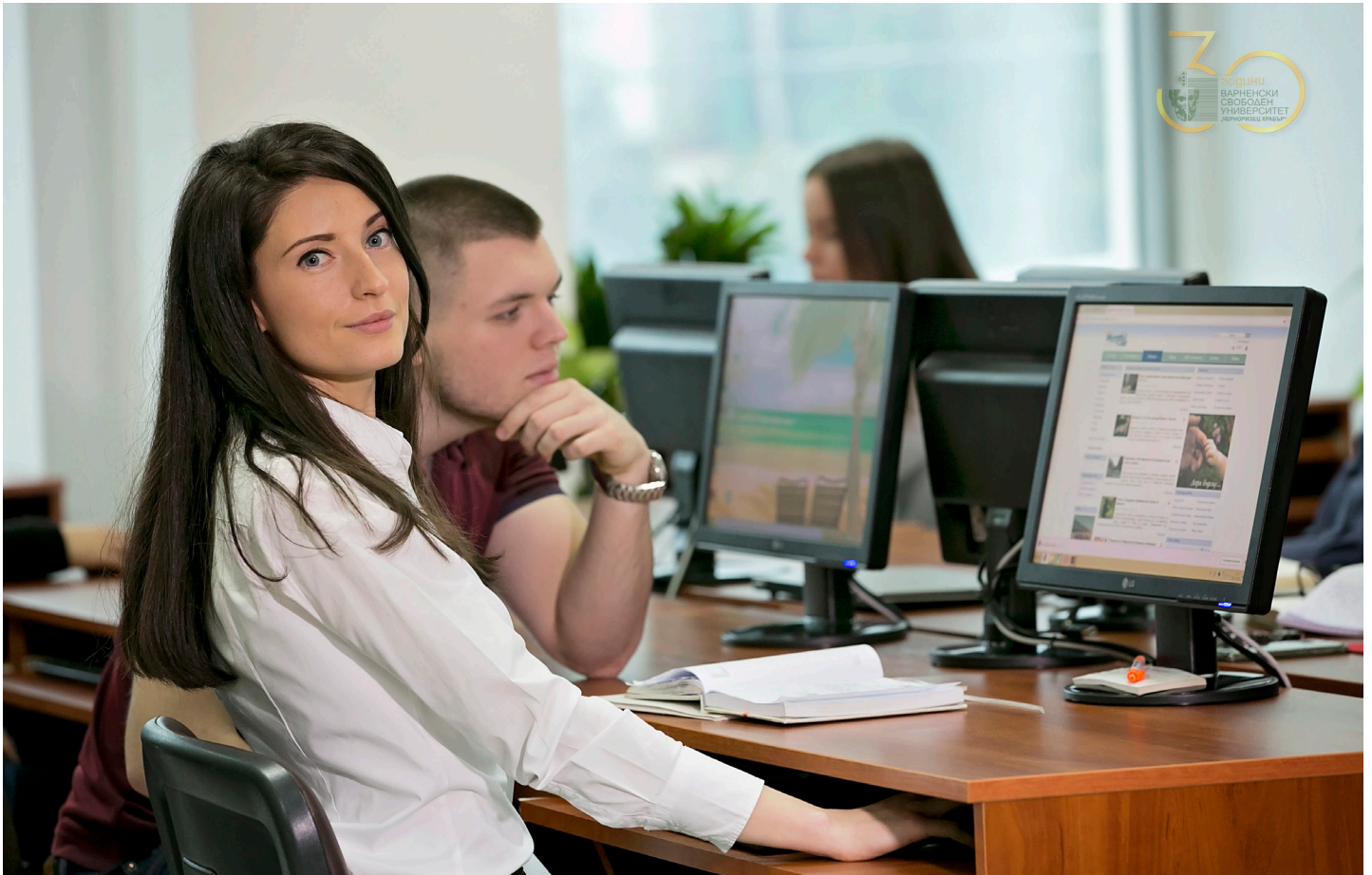
The possibility of successful professional realization attracted 76 percent of the students. The relevance of the studied courses is the leading factor in choosing a major for nearly 60% of students. More than half of them were attracted by the offered distance or part-time mode of study. For every second of the students, the leading factor was the excellent reputation of the major in which they study, and every third was impressed by the good university campus.

98.2 percent of all surveyed stated that they would recommend the major in which they are studying to their acquaintances and friends. Their number increased by 3.2% this year, compared to the previous one. 86% of the graduating bachelors expressed a desire to continue their studies in the next educational and qualification degree at Varna Free University, and their share for the last year increased by 7%.

MORE WORKING PEOPLE AND BULGARIANS WHO LIVE ABROAD CHOOSE DISTANCE LEARNING AT VFU “CHERNORITZ HRABER”
